CALL FOR PAPERS 2020/21

Fellow scholars,

We are excited to issue the call for papers for the Spring 2021 issue of *Studia Antiqua*—the twenty-year anniversary of the journal! We invite submissions pertaining to the ancient Near East or Mediterranean, including those on Greek, Roman, and Classical Studies. We hope to publish between **seven to ten research papers** and **two to three book reviews** in the 2021 issue.

We will be accepting submissions beginning now through **Friday, January 15, 2021**. This year we will only be accepting completed papers.

If your paper is accepted for publication, you will be notified before the end of March 2021. Please note that the final publication of an accepted paper is contingent upon your completion of recommended revisions, and that initial acceptances may be rescinded if you fail to complete such revisions in a reasonable timeframe.

If you hope to pursue graduate work in academia, we **highly encourage** you to pursue publishing opportunities like *Studia Antiqua*. Not only will you gain experience with the peer-review and editing process in a low-stakes environment, but a polished, published paper is a valuable resource to put on a CV or include as a writing sample in a graduate school application.
